REASON FOR CHANGE (S)

Benefits in producing the parts include better service from supplier (they will check coolant condition every 2 weeks), operator preference (less fuming and smell), less aggressive on the machine (metosol tended to strip paint), and about 10% less in price. For grinding, Beethoven VNF-2 will replace a neat oil, so there is no fire risk, and less tendency for grinding burns.
